If your lot has been missed or you have any other issues. please email Nikki at nikki@pointofwoodshoa.com. She is the contact for Blade Runners. If you do not have email, you can call the emergency line and they will get in contact with her.

Please note the HOA is not responsible for removing snow from parking spots or the sidewalks surrounding your homes.

Homeowners must shovel the sidewalks surrounding their homes. This is City Code. You can be sited for not doing so and if someone falls in front of your home because you failed to clear your sidewalk, you will be held liable.

Parking spaces should also be cleared by the homeowner. When shoveling parking spots or sidewalks, please pile the snow into your yard or common areas. Do not pile it in the parking lot or sidewalks.
